

**SHALLOTTE BOARD OF ALDERMEN**  
**BUDGET WORKSHOP**  
**APRIL 27, 2022**  
**3:30 P.M.**

The Shallotte Board of Aldermen met for a budget workshop on April 27, 2022 at 3:30 p.m. in the meeting chambers located at 110 Cheers Street with Mayor Walt Eccard presiding.

Aldermen present: Larry Harrelson, Jimmy Bellamy and Adam Stanley

Aldermen absent: Carson Durham and Gene Vasile

Staff present: Sandy Strickland, Mimi Gaither, Robert Waring and Isaac Norris

Mayor Eccard called the meeting to order. A motion was made by Jimmy Bellamy seconded by Adam Stanley to open the meeting. Motion carried 3 yes 0 no.

1. RFQ McGill Engineering (Price Landing – A motion was made by Larry Harrelson seconded by Adam Stanley to approve the Statement of Qualifications submitted by McGill Associates for Professional Design Services – Price Landing at Mulberry Park. Motion carried 3 yes 0 no.
2. Withers Ravenel SRF Application – A motion was made by Adam Stanley seconded by Larry Harrelson to accept the proposal for professional services in the amount of \$5,000 by WithersRavenel regarding the Water SRF Application. Motion carried 3 yes 0 no.
3. LGC Letter – A motion was made by Adam Stanley seconded by Jimmy Bellamy to approve a letter to the Local Government Commission responding to a comment the auditor made during the audit for the year ending 6/30/21 about a journal entry made to correct the ending inventory of supplies for the Water & Sewer fund. Motion carried 3 yes 0 no.
4. Riverfront Update – A map submitted by Allison Engebretson, Paramounte Engineering, illustrates the Town’s flood plain line and discussion was held on possible “platforms” being constructed for fishing.
5. Budget Workshop
  - Governing Body
  - Administration – Proposed 8% COLA and up to 2% merit
  - Planning – Proposed full time Planning position beginning January 2023
